

Joyful Partnership

Introduction

In our final study we look at Philippians 4vs10-23. In this passage Paul thanks the Philippians for their generous and sacrificial giving and passes on greetings from his fellow believers to the believers in Philippi. By calling them saints, Paul is echoing the description from chapter 1vs1 – a description which reminded the Philippian believers that their greatest privilege was not their Roman citizenship, but their citizenship of the kingdom of heaven (see 3vs20). In keeping with this, Paul now reminds them of the privilege and joy that he shares in gospel partnership with them in the service of Christ. In the process he also reminds them and us of the importance of contentment and generosity – both of which flow out of confidence that God is able to supply all our needs.
